Romans 6:23

The Promise/Prophecies

Gen 3.15; Isa 7:14 Seed of a woman Matthew says this is Jesus Mt 1:23

Gen 12:3; 22:18 Seed, singular, of Abraham (Gal 3.16)

Gen 49.10 promise of king through Judah

Then David 2 Sam 7.12-13 (Acts 2.30)

To be born in Bethlehem - Micah 5.2

In the days of the fourth kingdom of Daniel, the Roman Empire - Dan 2:44-45

Would receive his kingdom directly from God the Father - Dan 7:13-14

Christ came in the "fullness of time" Gal 4:4

Prophecies and miracles!

Miraculous signs from the Father had made this known to Peter - John 20:30-31; 21:25
